



Tcp Versions 3.10 and 5.10 have been released on July 10th, 2007. All readers shipped after July 10th will have the new firmware.

Version 3.1 is for NON-POE product. Version 5.1 is for POE readers.

These new versions allow you to change both the IP address and the subnet when using the Local Search screen in the latest IBC Tcp/ip utility Version 4.0.

Users no longer have to change the ip address on their computer in order to match the default subnet which is programmed into the reader. Using Version 4 of the utility, under the Local Search, you can now click on "Resolve Dup" and the program will prompt you for the new IP address, new subnet, and the reader password. You must enter in valid data for both the ip address prompt and the subnet prompt, even if you are not changing both of them.

Readers which contain Version 3.1 or 5.1 of the firmware will accept the changes for the IP address and subnet. Readers with earlier versions of the firmware will change the ip address only, since those firmware versions do not support the subnet change.
